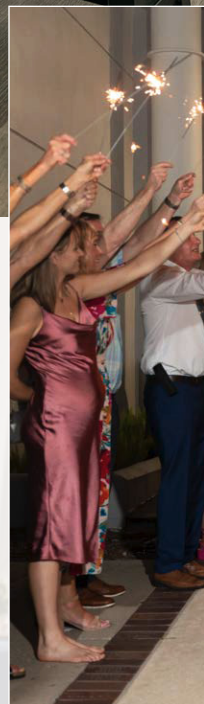
Say “I do” to history!

The Flight One Gallery is a 2,300-square-foot event space with breathtaking views of the downtown waterfront and St. Pete Pier. Bright natural light by day, downtown city lights by night, the Flight One Gallery has room for a dance floor and is equipped with state-of-the-art audio-visual technology, including a 79-square-foot video wall.*

The Main Gallery is a 3,500-square-foot additional event space, ideal as a cocktail hour space, that provides attendees the opportunity to experience the current exhibit on display. The Main Gallery is also made available as an alternative location for outdoor weddings in the event of rain.

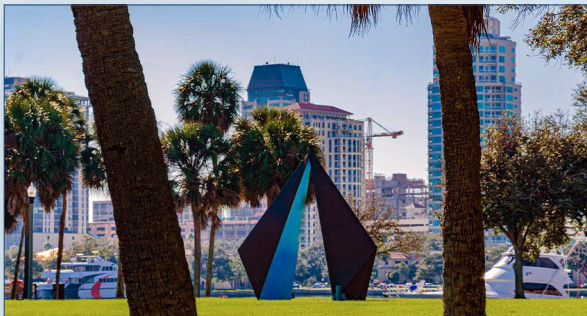

To reserve the facility, the Renter must sign and return a completed Venue Rental Agreement along with a deposit of 50% of the Total Venue Rental Fee. The Venue Rental balance and any additional fees are due 120 days prior to the Event Date. If the event is contracted less than 120 days prior to the Event Date, Total Venue Fees are due in full at the time the contract is signed and executed.

Prices do not include taxes. Payments made with a credit card are subject to a surcharge of up to 3% of the total cost.

*Based on five-hour standard event, plus two-hour set-up, and one-hour clean-up; additional hours outside of those included in the standard rental will be charged according to the schedule of Additional Services.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the standard rental time for a wedding and/or reception?

Standard event rates include five (5) hours for the event, plus two (2) hours of set-up and one (1) hour of clean-up. Additional time may be contracted for a fee. See Additional Service Rates.

What time of day can I host my wedding and/or reception at the Museum?

With rare exceptions, events are hosted outside of Museum operating hours. The Museum is open to the public Monday through Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and noon to 5:00 p.m. on Sundays. Early access for set-up, however, may be arranged in advance.

Where do I park while I am setting up for my wedding and/or reception?

One space is provided at the Museum's loading dock for loading/unloading supplies, which is located adjacent to the rear entrance (glass double doors) on a first-come, first-served basis.

Are there any limitations to the kinds of decorations I can use?

Generally speaking, you can decorate however you like so long as there is no permanent damage to the walls/floors/etc. and decorations do not require the Museum to remove any permanent exhibits.

We do have a few restrictions for you to be aware of: We cannot allow open flame inside the building due to fire risk (LED candles are welcome!) and we ask that you do not use glitter or confetti as it is nearly impossible to clean up.

Have a specific vision or theme for your decorations? Share it with us and we'll be happy to work with you!

Can I use my own caterer or do I have to use one designated by the Museum?

You are more than welcome to use your own caterer for your event. Please be aware that the Museum charges outside caterers a 15% surcharge on the catering total which often gets passed along to the client. You must use the Museum's liquor vendor for all alcoholic beverage services (even beer and wine) due to liquor licensing laws. Also, if the menu you select requires open flame for food preparation (such as a grill or torch), we have a designated covered area immediately outside the Museum that works well for this purpose.

Where can my guests park during my wedding and/or reception?

Parking is available in the St. Pete Pier lots and downtown parking garages. Should the client request, the Museum can arrange parking in the Dolphin Lot adjacent to the Museum. We can also arrange for trolley shuttle service to and from off-site lots. Reserved parking and shuttle service is based on availability. City parking and trolley fees apply.
